What is PACE?

Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) is a Medicare and Medicaid program that helps people meet their health care needs in the community instead of being admitted to a nursing home or other care facility. With PACE, you have a team of health care professionals working alongside you and your family to make sure you receive the coordinated care you need.

PACE of Northeast Indiana is a collaborative effort between Aging & In-Home Services of Northeast Indiana and Parkview Health. This strategic collaboration combines top-notch social services and clinical care to ensure PACE Participants receive the quality care they deserve. PACE of Northeast Indiana is a member of the National PACE Association (NPA).



PACE benefits include, but are not limited to, all Medicaid and Medicare covered services. PACE Participants receive the majority of their clinical and social services at the PACE Center.

PACE Participants must receive all needed health care services, including primary care and specialist physician services (other than emergency services), from PACE or an entity authorized by PACE.

82% are dually eligible for Medicaid and Medicare, **17%** are Medicaid only, **1%** pay a premiumⁱⁱ
